I will know (knowledge):

- Describe and understand physical and geography of mountains see key vocabulary.
- Locate and name and locate countries and cities around the world and identify their human and physical characteristics.
- Locate main alpine countries of Europe, i.e. France, Switzerland, Austria, Italy

I will be able to (skills):

- Ask and respond to questions about places and the environment by making comparisons.
- Offer explanations for the location of human and physical features in different localities.
- Locate countries in the world, including capital cities.
- Identify on a globe the position and significance of the equator, norther and southern hemispheres, tropics of Cancer and Capricorn and the Arctic and Antarctic circles.
- Identify features of a place using aerial photographs.
- Recording information through observation, more detailed sketches, questionnaires and surveys to collect information and investigate a place.
- Measure and record data e.g. weather in different parts of the school.
- Describe how people can both improve and damage the environment. Linking this to tourism, especially within the Alps.
